Please continue reading at least 3 times a week with your child.

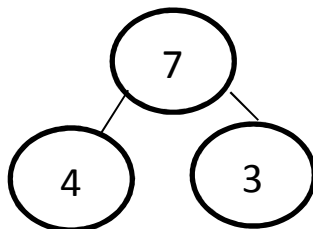
