The children have enjoyed reading our new story "Again" and continuing to learn all about Fire.

Spelling/Reading

Last week our word list was sent home. When you are reading the book you have taken home, please look out for the words on the list. Can you read them? Do you know what they mean?

Please continue reading at least 3 times a week with your child. Your child will have their new reading journals, please begin to fill these in to record any opportunities you have had to read with your child.

This can be any reading, not just the book sent home from school. Reading a favourite book, a magazine, research they have done on the internet or finding a new book to share from the library; all of these can be entered into the diary. An entry in the journal does not have to be at the end of a book, it is for each time your child reads to you - even if it just a page! We will start using our reading tree next week for children to work towards a reward.

Maths

Continue to support your child using MyMaths . If you have any problems using MyMaths, please speak to your child's class teacher.

Please continue to support your child with counting at home. Practise counting different objects and different methods of counting them.
