- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

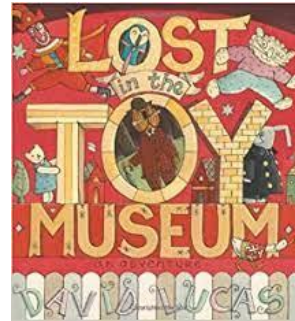
