#### Journey in Love

As in previous years, the first week back from half term will be our 'Safety Week'. During the week we will be thinking about how we can keep ourselves safe in the ever-changing world we live in.

As part of this week the RE sessions will cover '*A Journey in Love*'. This is a developmental programme for children in the primary years in line with Diocesan guidelines for the delivery of Sex and Relationship Education. It links very closely to '*Come and See*', the Catholic Primary RE programme.

*A Journey in Love* is compiled specifically to present a Catholic vision. In each Year group, an aspect of love is explored and developed, starting from Year R through to Year 6. The resources used have been agreed by the governors and the whole programme is delivered sensitively and in keeping with the Church's teachings and values.

If you would like to see the power points before the sessions are delivered, there will be sessions on **Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June, there will be three sessions in the classrooms, 3.15pm 3.30pm and 3.45pm.**

**You may attend any of the sessions - Each session will be exactly the same, it will just be repeated for families with children in more than one year group.**

You will be able to see the presentations and ask any questions that you might have.
